



Genesis & Genesis Optima

Manual Operation Guide

The following instructions demonstrate how to switch your Genesis Series operator into manual operation mode and then back into automatic operation. This can be particularly useful in the event of a power outage or a problem arising with your operator, allowing you to remove a trapped vehicle from your garage. Please note, you will likely need two people to complete this process and whilst your operator may not look identical to those illustrated, the process is the same for all units.



How to put in Manual Operation Mode:

To put the door into manual operation, pull down firmly on the red cord hanging from your operator whilst simultaniously lifting your door slightly.

Your door can now be manually raised so that any trapped vehicles can be removed.

How to put in Auto Operation Mode:

To put the door into auto operation, simply lower the door to it's original closed position. The manual release lever, currently in the down position) must be pushed back into place as per the above image. This can be done by hand or by positioning the cord at an approx 45 degree angle.

Your door can now be automatically operated.
